Lockdowns continue

As all Victorians are aware we are frequently going into and coming out of lockdown. This means the club constantly must keep up to date with the rules regarding access to the club.

At time of writing this means that we cannot use the club, either courts or clubrooms. **We have QR codes up in many places at the club and all visitors to the club must use these.** Please remember this when the lockdown ends; we are required to keep using them and have all people who visit the club register their visit until we are advised otherwise by the Victorian Government.
