Thank you to Craigieburn Tennis Club for their support over the last 4 terms, we look forward to continuing to work closely with the club and committee.

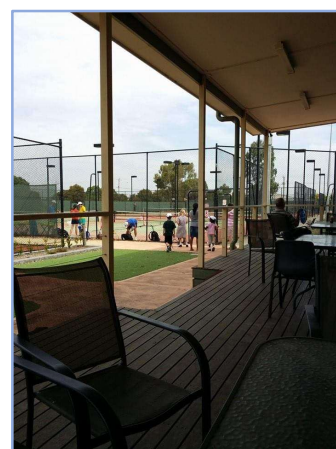
I have worked to build enrolments, with classes now running 4 days a week. With
